OLNCN 564 Old Olney Deeds SUMMARY

- 1 Bond between James Hyden and John Markes dated 9 July 1753, mentions Mary Henley.
- 2 Grant and release of a house in Olney dated Nov 1759 between Thos. Abbott, Mary Tapp, James Warr, Francis Warr, James Dunckley, Richard Boswell and Mary Butcher, also mentioning William Barringer, John Barringer, Elizabeth Warr and Mary Alsop.
- 3 33rd Geo 2 (1760) Mary Butcher paid £100 for one messuage (cottages, gardens and orchards in Olney) to Thomas and Katherine Abbott, James and Mary Dunkley and Richard and Mary Boswell.
- 4 Mortgage for two houses in North End, Newport Pagnell between Richard Mills and his wife Mary, and John Burnham dated 3 March 1764, mentions Francis Wilbey and Jonas Smith.
- 5 Assignment of Mortgage dated 9 March 1769 by Thos. Talbot (Executor of Rd. Leapidge) to Richd. Patch (in trust for James Matthews and his wife) mentioning Jonas Kendall alias Mills, Thomas Revis, Sarah Parrot, Richard Tooms, and land including the Inn called The Shoulder of Mutton in Newport Pagnell.
- 6 Release from Richard Mills to James Pike dated 14 April 1775, for land in North End, Newport Pagnell, mentioning Jonas Smith, John Read, Elizabeth Smith, Mary Curtis, Mary Smith, Stephen Hoddle, John Burnham and Jon Abbott.
- 7 23 Geo 3rd (1783) Sale of four messuages in Olney by John and Mary Bannister to Robert York for £60.
- 8 Assignment of Mortgage of Mrs Ann Burnham to Mr Thomas Handson, dated 15 April 1775 for land in North End, Newport Pagnell, mentioning Richard Mills, John Burnham, James Pike, Stephen Hoddle, Mary Curtis, Jonas Smith and Jonathan Abbott.
- 9 Deed of Covenant from William Bannister to Jos. Todd dated 29 August 1801, relates to grant of a house dated Nov 1759, Mary Butcher 1760 and sale of four messuages 1783. The house seems to be 14 High Street South, Olney.
- 10 A Feoffment from Edward Henley Lambert to Joseph Todd dated 17 March 1808 of a piece of land in Olney for £5, mentions Ann Marriott. The land seems to be 16 High Street South, Olney.
- 11 A Feoffment from Sarah Todd and Joseph Todd (her son) to William Jefferson dated 14 October 1817 of a messuage and brewhouse in Olney for £155. Mentions J H Talbot, John

Bannister, Ann Marriott, Martha Adams, John Robinson, Joseph Wadsworth, Ebenezer Norman, Thomas Dumvile, (see 10 EH Lambert to J Todd). The premises seem to be 14 High Street South, Olney.

12 An assignment from Thomas Talbot and EH Lambert (schoolmaster) dated 13 April 1819 to John Garrard of two tenements in High Street, Olney adjoining land of William Jefferson. (also mentions Thomas Dumvile, William Clarke, Charlotte Arrowsmith, Elizabeth Barringer, Thomas Ward, William Wilmer, William Hoff, and Ebenezer Rogue.) The premises seem to be 18 and 16 High Street South, Olney.

13 Release of a messuage, bakehouse and land from J Whitworth and J Perry to W. Gee dated 29 Sept 1820, naming many residents, past and present, in and around Dag Lane, Olney, and mentioning Thomas Dumvile, Joseph Harrold, John Garrard, John Bannister, Joseph Todd, William Bannister, James Dumvile, Mr Pitts, Ann Arrowsmith, Ebenezer Negus, Edward Lambert, and Robert York. The premises seem to be 14 High Street South, Olney.

14 Copy Administration Thomas Aspray deceased 1839.

15 Declaration by Ebenezer Aspray in support of title 1839. The premises seem to be 23 Market Place, Olney.

16 Will of John Osborn 1841.

17 Conveyance of property in Olney from William and Elizabeth Lord to Elizabeth, George and Elizabeth Lord dated 15 Dec 1851, mentions E H Lambert, Peter Freeman, John Limbrey, Joseph Thompson, John Osborn, William Jefferson and John Hutchings. See grant dated 1808, feoffment dated 1817, assignment dated 1819 and release dated 1820. The premises are 18 and 16 High Street South, Olney.

18 Succession of property in Olney John Osborn to Thomas Osborn dated 1853, see will of John Osborn 1841. The premises seem to be 20 High Street South, Olney.

19 Conveyance of premises in Olney from Gervase Smith Hives and George Jefferson to Joel Davison dated 29 September 1854, mentions Joseph Wadsworth, Ebenezer Negus, John Hutchings, John Bannister, Thomas Dumvile, Thomas Osborn, E H Lambert, John L Lumbrey, Joseph Thompson, and Richard Foskett. See conveyance dated 15 Dec 1851. The premises seem to be 14 High Street South, Olney.

20 Declaration by Elizabeth Smith dated 3 October 1854 about the possession of a house and land in Olney, adjoining the Swan Inn, occupied by John Hutchings, late owned by William Jefferson, mentions Joseph and Ebenezer Negus, Joseph Wadsworth and John Osborn. The house seems to be 14 High Street South, Olney.

21 Mortgage of premises in Olney opposite Dag Lane, dated 8 September 1855 by Thomas Osborn to Charles Whitworth, mentions Thomas Forster, William Bannister, Thomas Dumvile, John Osborn, Mr Pitts, James Whitlock, William George and Elizabeth Lord, and Mr Lambert. See conveyance of 1854. The premises seem to be 14 High Street South, Olney.

22 Three conveyances on the one sheet of parchment (1) conveyance from Joel Davison to Geo. Grindon, Thomas Osborn and George Field dated 19 August 1880, (2) conveyance from George Field to George Field, William W Wright and George C Raban dated 20 May 1896, and (3) conveyance from G. Field, W.W.Wright and G.C.Raban to Trustees of Independent Order of Oddfellows, mentioning G S Hives, G Jefferson, J Wykes, M Hinde, J Hutchings, G Lord, J L Limbrey, G Thompson, J Ruffhead, R Foskett, S Litchfield and Walter Andrews dated 13 April 1908. See mortgage dated 1855 and conveyance dated

1854. The premises are 14 High St. South, Olney.

23 Conveyance of two premises in Olney dated 17 September 1881 from George and Elizabeth Lord to Thomas Eyles and Thomas T Coles, mentions William Lord, John Toon, E H Lambert, Peter Freeman, John Limbrey, Joseph and George Thompson, John Ruffhead, John and Thomas Osborn, Edward and Joel Jefferson and John Hutchings. See conveyance dated 1854 and 1851. The premises are 18 and 16 High Street South, Olney.

24 Fire insurance policy wrapper Mr A J Osborn Xmas 1896

25 Invoice from A Osborn to Garrard & Allen to re-convey property in Olney date 27 March 1900

26 Deed for land at Hissey Leys and Hissey Meadow to be let by Earl of Dartmouth to A J Osborn dated 2 November 1900 (1929)

27 Abstract of property in Olney from Joseph Todd dated 28 December 1790, referring to grant of November 1759, Mary Butcher transfer, sale of four messuages dated 1783.

28 Invoice dated April 1900 to build wall on north side of Cowper's garden

29 Provisional valuation of a cottage in High St, Olney owned by A J Osborn, butcher, and occupied by J Whitchfield dated 26 Jan 1912.

30 Provisional valuation of house and shop owned by A J Osborn, butcher, and occupied by George Hooton dated 25 April 1913 at 20 High Street South, Olney.

31 Envelope addressed to Mr A Osborn "Mr Clarabut left Insurance receipt 1917"

32 Undertaking between Earl of Dartmouth and H J Osborn dated 24 August 1920 to sale of a freehold hereditament in Olney.

33 Modification plans for A.H.Smith's Almshouses, Olney dated 1978 plus transcript of Ann Smith's will dated 1851.
